Riviera Sauvignon Blanc (France)

Notes of gooseberries and tropical fruit with a refreshing finish, this Sauvignon is bone-dry and deliciously refreshing.

Hen Pecked Picpoul de Pinet (France)

The wines of Picpoul de Pinet are crisp, bright and refreshing.

Aroha Bay Marlborough Sauvignon (New Zealand)

A delicate Chardonnay with tropical fruits, it is enjoyed best with light and spicy dishes.

Riviera Merlot (France)

A soft, elegant and easy drinking Merlot with light and supple tannins.

Bacca Nera Negroamaro Primitivo (Italy)

A modern styled with a sweeter fruit feel. This is sophisticated, full-bodied, intense and packed with blackberries.

Bushranger Shiraz (Australia)

A deliciously fruity red, full of classic ripe red fruit and berry flavours, with an added touch of Shiraz spice on the finish.

Very deep ruby-red tones, brilliant and clean. The texture is supple with ripe tannins.

Chateauneuf du Pape Cigale Rouge

A traditional Châteauneuf-du-Pape with a peppery, leathery nose. The palate is dry with spices, pepper and a hint of vanilla before a delicious, firm finish.

Azabache Rioja Crianza (Spain)

Aromas of candied red and black fruit, integrated with soothing vanilla and toasted notes provided by the wood.

Vallet Frères Santenay Premier Cru 'Les Gravières' (France)

Lightly smoky with plump red fruits, vegetal earthiness and a twist of acidity on the finish.

Barolo Flori DOCG Araldica (Italy)

Plum, mulberry, ripe strawberry and brown spice with delicate floral and violet notes. The tannins are firm, supported by a round silky texture.

Vallet Frères Gevrey-Chambertin Premier Cru 'Les Cazetiers' (France)

Delicate sweet strawberry fruit, fresh acidity and a clean, vibrant palate.

ROSÉ

Blush Zinfandel Cougars Moon (USA)

Flavours of juicy redcurrant, fresh raspberry, melon, peach, and apricot hints.

Pinot Grigio Robinia Rosé (Italy)

A fresh and appealing style of Pinot Grigio rosé. The addition of early-harvested Pinot Noir grapes gives a delicate salmon pink colour and subtle red berry fruit.

Domaine Valfont Provence Rosé (France)

The nose is pretty, unveiling floral aromas of bergamot and sweet jasmine as well as bouquet of exotic and red berry fruits. The palate picks up notes of mango and lychee with a more savoury edge of peach-stone and citrus.

SPARKLING WINE AND CHAMPAGNE

Vispo Allegro Prosecco Spumante (Italy)

Delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes reminiscent of peach and green apple. Fresh and light on the palate with balanced acidity.

Champagne Taittinger Nocturne City Lights (France)

Presented in a beautiful celebratory bottle decorated with sparkling lights, this is an exceptional "Sec" champagne.

DESSERT WINE

Domaine de Grange Neuve Monbazillac (France)

A blend of Semillon with a little Muscadelle and Sauvignon Blanc, the result is luscious with complex fruit and fine acidity to give a fresh finish. It rivals many of its more expensive neighbours in Sauternes.
